Manufacturer's specific instructions for your hurricane sliding door should also include the following, provided these instructions do not tarnish the manufacturer's warranty:

-Fill old screw and fastener holes with weatherproof sealant:

This is a good practice to prevent water infiltration and enhance the overall weather resistance of the installation. Using a weatherproof sealant will help protect against moisture and improve the longevity of the installation.

-Pre-drill all new anchoring fastener holes:

Pre-drilling holes can make the installation process smoother and reduce the risk of splitting or damaging the material. It allows for precise placement of fasteners and ensures a secure attachment without causing unnecessary stress on the door or frame.

-Use non-corrosion or Porcelain-coated fasteners:

Choosing non-corrosive or Porcelain-coated fasteners is crucial for durability, especially in areas prone to high humidity or salt exposure. This helps prevent rust and corrosion, ensuring the fasteners maintain their integrity over time.

-Apply a polyethylene film (Vycor) on sill and rough opening as flashing:

Adding a polyethylene film like Vycor on the sill and rough opening as flashing, provides an additional layer of protection against water intrusion. It helps create a waterproof barrier and enhances the overall weatherproofing of the installation.
